### Wisconsin Builders Association Statement on Signing of Workforce Housing Package

June 23, 2023 – The Wisconsin Builders Association (WBA) commended Governor Evers' signature of a workforce housing package that will increase the supply of affordable housing in Wisconsin.

"The lack of affordable housing across Wisconsin is at a critical level," said WBA President Mike Howe. "Funding loans through the Wisconsin Housing and Economic Development Authority for workforce housing residential infrastructure costs, main street multifamily remodeling projects, the conversion of commercial buildings for housing, and single-family remodeling projects is an important way to lower the cost of housing for many working families throughout Wisconsin. Excessive and outdated regulations add over \$93,000 to the final price of a new home, increasing the total by nearly 24 percent. Coupled with 75 percent fewer lots and 55 percent fewer new homes than pre-recession averages, volatile interest rates, and inflated costs of materials, these bills will go a long way in assisting a variety of challenges in the creation of workforce housing."

"We are thankful for the bipartisan work done to enact this legislation; to our industry partners in advocating for this legislation, Representative Brooks and Senator Quinn for spearheading it, the Joint Committee on Finance for approving funding, the legislature for passing them, and Governor Evers for signing the bills into law," said WBA Executive Director Brad Boycks. "These measures will provide additional tools for developers, builders, remodelers, and local units of government to build muchneeded workforce housing units across Wisconsin."

### Research Report by Massachusetts HBA Urges Action on Housing and Climate



June 30, 2023 - The <u>Home Builders and Remodelers Association of Massachusetts (HBRAMA)</u> recently released a report, "<u>Public Policy for Net Zero Homes and Affordability</u>," in which researchers from the MIT Center for Real Estate and Wentworth Institute of Technology analyzed the confluence of the housing and climate crises on building costs and, consequently, housing affordability, along with the potential effects of the state's recently passed "net zero" residential building code.

The 18-month study concluded that, without additional incentives or financial supports, the more stringent building requirements will likely push homeownership out of reach for many more families in Massachusetts.

The report estimates that the specialized stretch energy code is likely to increase the cost of home construction by roughly 1.8% to 3.8% — adding approximately \$10,000 to \$23,000 to the median cost of a single-family home and putting homeownership out of reach for between 15,000 and 33,000 households. The researchers also estimated a 2.4% rise in construction costs for large multifamily buildings.

"When it comes to housing policy, we must balance the scales in these two vital areas – affordability and climate change. Our policymakers must avoid tilting too far in one direction to the detriment of the other," said HBRAMA President Jeffrey Brem in a press release. "Legislative and regulatory efforts at the state and local levels should be geared toward accelerating the construction of housing that is more energy-efficient but also more equitable, more attainable and more affordable to a larger pool of Massachusetts residents."

The research team identified a series of policy tools that could facilitate the production of more energy-efficient and affordable housing, including:

- Implementing land use changes that reduce carbon emissions and increase affordability.
- Streamlining permitting and reducing utility connection delays.
- Restructuring financial incentives and tax credits.
- Increasing technical assistance for green building.
- Expanding financing sources.
- Supporting low-income renters.
- Creating new tax classifications and exemptions.

The study was supported by a diverse array of organizations, including the Air Conditioning, Heating and Refrigeration Institute, the Building Industry Association of Washington, Cape Cod Five, Housing Assistance Corporation, Massachusetts Association of Realtors, National Association of Home Builders, Planning Office for Urban Affairs at the Archdiocese of Boston, Propane Education and Research Council, Pulte Homes, Mitsubishi Electric, Sunpower and Toll Brothers.

Information from the study has been well publicized in local media since its release, including <u>CBS</u> <u>News Boston</u>, <u>Boston Business Journal</u>, <u>NBC Boston</u>, <u>Mass Live</u> and local Gannett outlets. The full report is available through <u>HBRAMA's website</u>.


